There is not a separate application form to submit in addition to the above materials. Your name should be included on each page of your application packet.

Enclose a copy of your resume. Be sure that it includes your e-mail address, school address and phone number, student ID number, permanent address and phone number, major, and expected graduation date as well as work history and a history of volunteer or extra-curricular activities.

#### **Essay Questions**

Use one page total (not one page per question) to answer all three of the following questions.

How do you demonstrate your passion for technology outside the classroom?

What was the most difficult technical problem you have had to solve? Describe the problem, how you addressed it, what your role was in solving it (if you were a part of a team), and what the outcome was.

How do you demonstrate initiative and willingness to go above and beyond?
